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ABSTRACT

This study aims to find out the improvement of speaking process skills through Jigsaw learning techniques and 2 stay 2 stray techniques. The research method used was true experimental two groups pretest posttest design in which the sampling technique is was purposive sampling. The numbers of research were 30 students. This research was conducted at SMA Negeri Ayotupas State High School in 2019/2020 with class XI-MIA1 as an experimental class. The instruments used in this study were written tests including pretest, posttest and student feedback during the study. The data analysis technique used the normality test through the Kolmogorof Smirnov test, an increase test through paired sample t-test and independent sample t test, and recapitulation of student feedback results. The result of research was Jigsaw technique had 42.67 and 2 Stay 2 Stray had 47.33, the mean score was 62.67 for Jigsaw and 60.00 for 2 stay 2 stray techniques after treatment. Thus the alternative hypothesis (H1) was accepted and the null hypothesis (H0) was rejected. In conclusion, the use of jigsaw and 2 stay 2 stray techniques were effective, even though in this research, specifically, Jigsaw technique is more effective than 2 stay 2 stray. Thus, both techniques are effective to teach speaking towards 2nd grade students in Ayotupas State High School

INTRODUCTION
