There were 3 error collocation found in students' abstract specifically in Grammatical collocation. The data analysis emphasizes the importance of collocation accuracy in academic writing. In summary, this research reveals various of English collocations employed by students in their thesis abstracts and offered some practical advice for IPS and future researchers.
